(if you have one)
- ✔ **Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN)**
(if you have one)
- ✔ **List of Colleges You are Interested in Attending**
- ✔ **Any Records of Untaxed Income**
(such as social security and veterans benefits)
- ✔ **Two-Year Prior Tax Information**
(1040s and w2s, if applicable)
